3. 146.595 (Simplex)
4. 147.195 PI 94.8 (simplex repeater output) please use PI Tone 94.8
5. 147.795 (Simplex) Repeater input and should only be used when directed, no tone.
6. 441.625 + PI 123.0 (Repeater)
7. 446.100 (Simplex)
8. 441.625 (Simplex) Repeater output, no tone.
9. 3923 KHz Tar Heel Emergency Net
10. 7230 KHz Tar Heel Emergency Net. (Daytime)
11. 146.850- Back up Repeater Barrettes Mtn (Hickory)
12. 145.090 - Packet (W4ERT/PBBS – TAYLOR/NODE – TVILLE/DIGI)
13. 144.390 APRS

The above listed frequencies are to be used at the discretion of the EC and/or the Net Control. Primary channel #1 should always be used and monitored by all members until otherwise, designated.
